- It is the contracted umpire's responsibility to meet requirements for working state tournaments. _____

These requirements are:

1. Register as an Indiana ASA Umpire with the Indiana ASA State Commissioner **and**
2. Attend a State or National ASA Umpire School in the year or previous two (2) years of the tournament **and**
3. **If** said school requirement has been met within prior two (2) years, umpire must attend an approved Indiana ASA rules clinic in the year of the tournament **and**
4. Submit a completed ASA Umpire test to the State Umpire-in-Chief prior to the tournament.
5. Wear "official" Indiana ASA Umpire uniform, including: navy blue slacks, powder blue Elbeco® pull-over shirt, fitted ASA cap.
